READINGS 21ST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME—YEAR (Isaiah 66: 18-21 - 'They will bring all your brothers from all the nations'

First Reading

Understanding the Gospel

As this parable opens, Luke reminds us the question about that only a few be saved uses typical Christian language about salvation. But it also expresses the Jewish concern about whether everyone who calls himself a Jew is actually faithful to the covenant. Jesus answers that they must strive in the time remaining to enter through the narrow door because many will be trying to get in but won't be strong enough. He then moves to a parable about another door. Once all those entering the master's house are in and he locks the door, there will be no way for others to get in. Those left outside may knock, but the master will say he doesn't know them. Unlike the Gospel reading from a few weeks ago where Jesus was teaching about prayer, and we were told to knock and the door would be opened, in this parable, the master will not open and say he does not know us. The image of the door is replaced in the final verses of the parable with the image of the heavenly banquet. Isaiah 43:5-6 speaks of God bringing Israel's descendants back from the east and from the west, the north and the south. And Isaiah 25:6 speaks of the Lord providing a feast of rich foods and choice wines for all peoples on his holy mountain. The answer to the question if only a few will be saved is no. In the end, many will be saved, but many who thought they would be saved will not be saved. The parable is a prophetic warning to repentance in order to enter the kingdom.

FEAST OF THE WEEK-29TH AUGUST

THE Passion of St John the Baptist



Today the Universal church celebrates the Memorial of the Passion of St John the Baptist. As the precursor to Jesus Christ, St John the Baptist has a unique role in salvation history. To prepare the way of the Lord, by his life and in his death. By his martyrdom we are reminded that those who boldly proclaim truth, the way, and the life of Jesus, in an increasingly hostile beyond-secular, and post Christian age, face the harshest forms of persecution today. A world that denies the sacredness of human life in all its forms - even for the most vulnerable among us, the unborn child in her mother's womb - is one that will always be hostile to the message of Jesus Christ. Through his birth, preaching and baptising, he bore witness to the coming birth, preaching and baptism of Christ, and by his own suffering he showed that Christ also would suffer. The final stage of John the Baptist's passion was his unjust imprisonment and beheading at the hands of King Herod. What was the ultimate factor that had Herod execute John? It was the fact that John told Herod that marrying his brother's wife, Herodias, was wrong. John is in fact a martyr to the sanctity of marriage & to the truth of the Gospel of Jesus Christ!
