

EASTER SUNDAY
Resurrection of the Lord
17th APRIL 2022



First reading

Acts 10:34,37-43

Peter addressed Cornelius and his household: 'You must have heard about the recent happenings in Judaea; about Jesus of Nazareth and how he began in Galilee, after John had been preaching baptism. God had anointed him with the Holy Spirit and with power, and because God was with him, Jesus went about doing good and curing all who had fallen into the power of the devil. Now I, and those with me, can witness to everything he did throughout the countryside of Judaea and in Jerusalem itself: and also to the fact that they killed him by hanging him on a tree, yet three days afterwards God raised him to life and allowed him to be seen, not by the whole people but only by certain witnesses God had chosen beforehand. Now we are those witnesses – we have eaten and drunk with him after his resurrection from the dead – and he has ordered us to proclaim this to his people and to tell them that God has appointed him to judge everyone, alive or dead. It is to him that all the prophets bear this witness: that all who believe in Jesus will have their sins forgiven through his name.'

Second reading Colossians 3:1-4

Since you have been brought back to true life with Christ, you must look for the things that are in heaven, where Christ is, sitting at God's right hand. Let your thoughts be on heavenly things, not on the things that are on the earth, because you have died, and now the life you have is hidden with Christ in God. But when Christ is revealed – and he is your life – you too will be revealed in all your glory with him.

Gospel John 20:1-9

It was very early on the first day of the week and still dark, when Mary of Magdala came to the tomb. She saw that the stone had been moved away from the tomb and came running to Simon Peter and the other disciple, the one Jesus loved. 'They have taken the Lord out of the tomb' she said 'and we don't know where they have put him.'

So Peter set out with the other disciple to go to the tomb. They ran together, but the other disciple, running faster than Peter, reached the tomb first; he bent down and saw the linen cloths lying on the ground, but did not go in. Simon Peter who was following now came up, went right into the tomb, saw the linen cloths on the ground, and also the cloth that had been over his head; this was not with the linen cloths but rolled up in a place by itself. Then the other disciple who had reached the tomb first also went in; he saw and he believed. Till this moment they had failed to understand the teaching of scripture, that he must rise from the dead.

SIGNIFICANCE OF EASTER:

The Resurrection of Christ is the basis of our Christian Faith. *"If Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is in vain; and your Faith is in vain" (1 Cor 15:14). "Jesus is Lord, He is risen" (Rom 10:9),* was the central theme of "preaching of the Apostles.

Easter is the guarantee of our own resurrection.

Easter is a feast which gives us hope and encouragement in this world of pain, sorrows and tears.

Easter gives meaning to our prayers: It supports our belief in the Real Presence of the Risen Jesus in and around us, in His Church, in the Blessed Sacrament and in Heaven, hearing our prayers, and so gives meaning to our personal as well as our communal prayer.

*Sin killed Him on Friday.
He killed sin on Sunday.*

*Death-forces destroyed Him on Friday.
He rose victorious on Sunday.*

*Falsehood sentenced Him on Friday.
Truth vindicated Him on Sunday.*

*His death was certified on Friday.
His resurrection was proclaimed on Sunday.*

*He was humiliated and maltreated on Friday.
His name was praised and exalted on Sunday.*

*On Friday life was stolen from Him.
On Sunday life was restored to Him.*

*Chronologically the distance between Friday and Sunday
Is just seventy-two hours.*

*Theologically the distance is enormous.
The distance between mortality and immortality.*

*Between shameful death and glorious resurrection
Between abject humiliation and splendid glorification*

It is a leap from human's time to God's eternity.


